# Certificate II in Plumbing Services

## 11054NAT

This qualification provides students with the fundamental knowledge and practical skills required for work in the plumbing and construction industries. Students learn how to work safely on construction sites, handle plumbing tools and materials, perform basic plumbing tasks, work at heights, carry out levelling, and communicate effectively in trade workplaces.

Completion of this qualification prepares students for apprenticeship opportunities in plumbing, gas fitting, roof plumbing and mechanical services.
