This qualification provides students with industry-relevant nursing support skills aligned to one of Australia's fastest-growing employment sectors. Learners develop knowledge in medical terminology, healthy body systems, first aid, infection control, and direct assistance to nursing staff in acute settings.

This is Year 2 of the health pathway and requires successful completion of Certificate II in Health Support Services.
